


Once upon a time, there was a sweet little grandma, everyone knew her as "Granny". She was very very kind and she lived in a beautiful, big house.


Granny started by saying: Once upon a time a very, very old crab, almost as old as me, called to all the others crabs one day to say:


One day, a little very clever crab thought: why do we have to walk forward if all the other crabs walk backwards?

But when he opened the box, he saw that the box was empty. So he shouted angrily: "Don't you know, when you give a gift, it must have something inside?






Oh daddy! It isn't empty, it isn't empty I blew many, many kisses in the box. And all them are for you daddy,". sSaid the girl crying.


Ariana and Benjamin began to think about the beach and how everyone takes care of their privates parts.




chocolate milk, with little colored sugar umbrellas. It was so, so delicious, that they forgot that Granny had to tell them something super nice!

"Mmm... we don't know only sometimes" said Granny. "So then how is it born?" asked Ariana. Granny showed them a book and she explained how a baby is born.




